

Cookie Policy

Effective as of March 30, 2023.

This Cookie Policy explains how Glynn Capital, Inc. (“**Glynn Capital**”, “**we**”, “**us**” or “**our**”) uses cookies and similar technologies in connection with the www.glynncapital.com website and any other website that we own or control and which posts or links to this Cookie Policy (collectively, the “**Sites**”).

What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies serve different purposes, like helping us understand how a site is being used, letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, and generally improving your browsing experience.

What are the key concepts?

First-party cookies. These cookies are served directly by us to your computer or mobile device, which we use to recognize your computer or mobile device when it revisits our Sites.

Persistent cookies. They are cookies that remain on a user's device for the period of time specified in the cookie. They are activated each time that the user visits the website that created that particular cookie.

Session cookies. These cookies allow website operators to link the actions of a user during a browser session. A browser session starts when a user opens the browser window and finishes when they close the browser window. Session cookies are created temporarily. Once you close the browser, all session cookies are deleted.

What are the categories and purposes of the cookies used on the Sites?

We use “strictly necessary” cookies on our Sites: These cookies are necessary for the Sites to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the Sites will not then work. We use these strictly necessary cookies to identify you as being logged in to the Sites and to authenticate you, to make sure you connect to the right service on the Sites when we make any changes to the way it works and for security purposes.

What types of cookies and similar tracking technologies does Glynn Capital use on the Sites?

On the Sites, we use cookies and other tracking technologies in the following categories described in the table below.

We may use browser web storage (including via HTML5), also known as locally stored objects (“LSOs”), for similar purposes as cookies. Browser web storage enables the storage of a larger amount of data than cookies. Your web browser may provide functionality to clear your browser web storage.

Our Sites place only strictly necessary cookies, meaning that you do not have to take any actions to accept or reject them.
